Students study both Old and New Testament narratives, learning to understand and apply biblical principles in their daily lives.

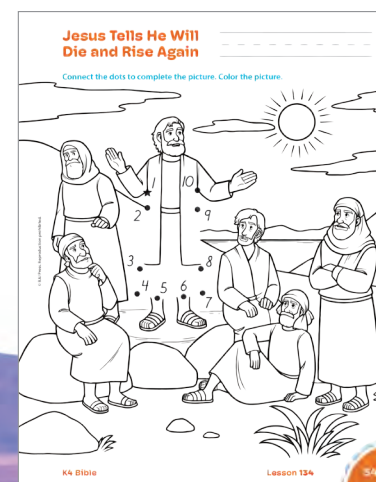
