Improving One’s Writing Craft

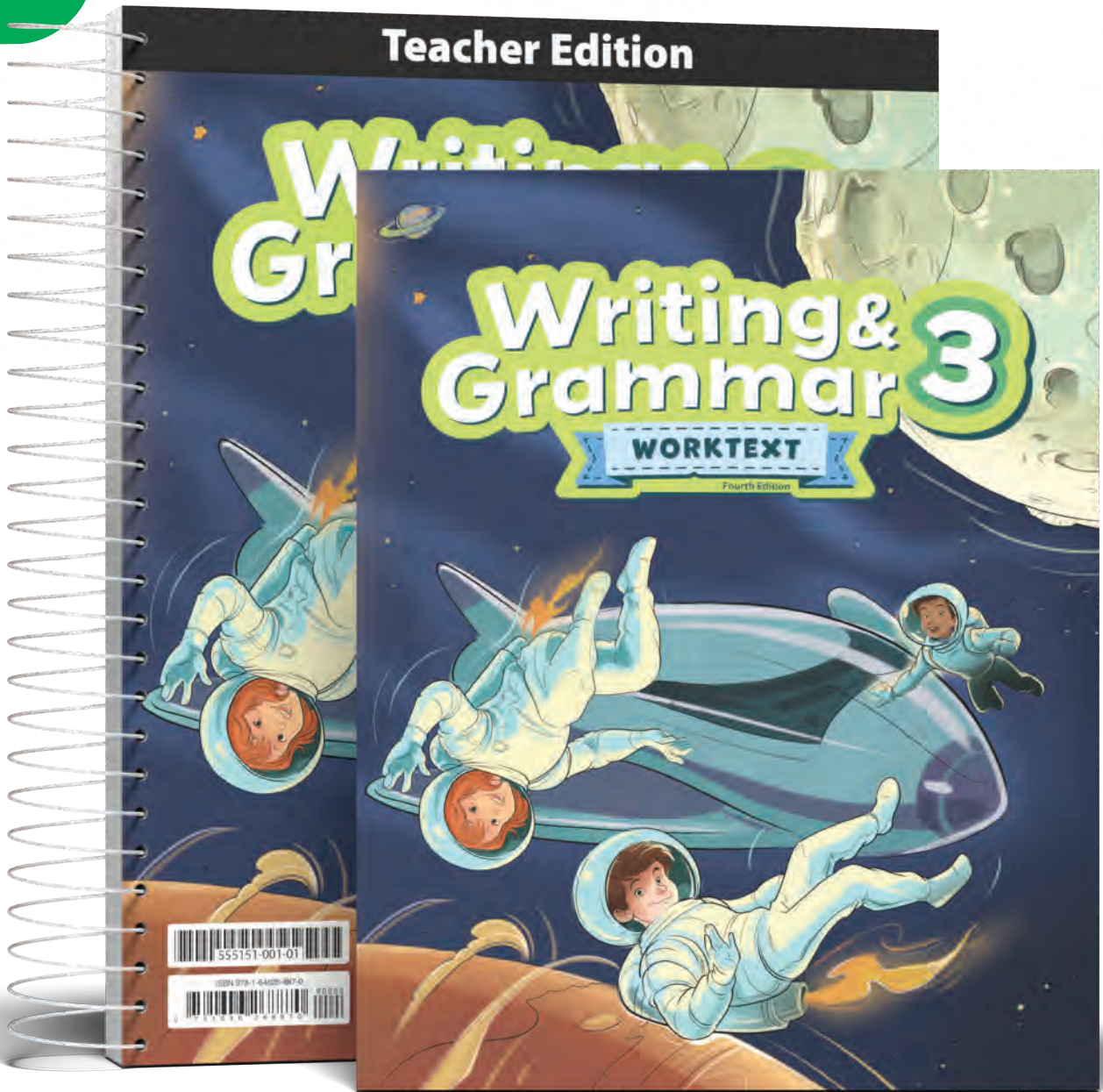
