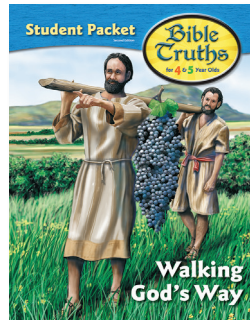

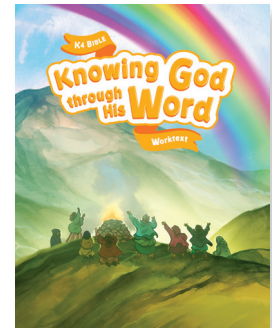
EDITION COMPARISON
