
The lesson plan overviews at the beginning of each chapter have been expanded to include clear objectives, resources, and assessments for every lesson. The teaching cycle model has been applied to each TE chapter to provide more structure, focus, and teacher guidance. Additionally, the content now includes stronger support for shaping a biblical worldview, with themes developed throughout the book and Biblical Worldview Shaping (BWS) overviews at the start of each chapter. Each BWS objective is clearly tagged with related statements, offering guidance for teachers on integrating biblical principles.

To better align with academic standards, several key concepts have been added, including future verbs, prepositions, articles and demonstrative adjectives, and compound sentences. Content and lessons have been revised, reorganized, and expanded to better support standards for pronouns and research skills.
